Saltwater does appear to be seeping from the end caps of the transmission cooler. Primary fuel filter is a racor 900MA. Engine oil sample came back good. Transmission oil sample was flagged for high water and copper. The transmission cooler could be failing and allowing water in the oil. Recommend replacing the transmission cooler and changing the oil.
